

- Council also approved a motion amending the building use policy to not allow animals in the church aside from service animals as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- The church ordered a purple stole for Mac Mullins, who recently graduated from Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary. He will be ordained this Saturday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Durham and will begin his call at St. Paul Lutheran in Davenport,

- A congregational vote will take place this Sunday to:
  - Approve the primary candidate Pastor William Ridenhour to become our next senior pastor
  - Approval of a compensation package


