THE YOUTH MINISTRY HAS BEEN ON THE RUN!



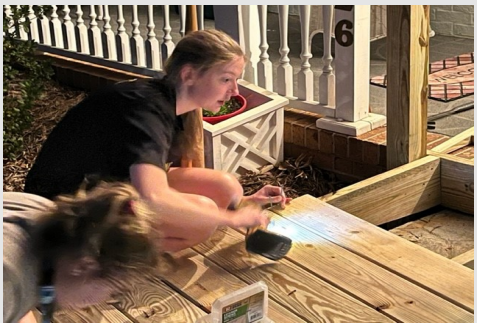
