This Week's Lesson...

Prayer and Humility - Genesis 18:25-27; Luke 18:9-14; 1 John 5:14-15

The three passages in today's lesson address prayer from distinct angles. In Genesis, Abraham pleads for mercy while acknowledging his own subordinate status. In Luke, the tax collector prays for mercy because he knows his own sinfulness, and in 1 John, Christians are encouraged to pray with confidence because of their relationship with God and knowing His disposition to listen to His children. Prayer works because we know God's character. The better we know God, the more we seek God, the more our prayers will be answered because they will align with who God is and what God wants to do in the world!
