• VP League/Operations

- Season 2021 -

- We will gauge the situation depending on regulations at the time.

• <u>VP Facilities/Projects</u>

- Washcar is SOLD. Roughly \$17,500. It did not have to go to auction. Someone came to pick it up. Had an electrician come and do a proper disconnect.
- Beginning of March, a windstorm completely destroyed one of the dugouts. We will need to have a new one built. We will pay a \$1000 deductible. Wawanessa/Smith Insurance said that we are not insured like we thought we were. Basically we need to be insured for 90% of our assets, but we are only covered for about \$48,000 about 40%
 - New dugout will be about \$10,000, and insurance is saying we will now owe about \$4700=\$5000 to cover the price of the dugout.
 - Adam has reached out to the insurance to get all the past transactions, info and everything we are covered for. We will look at other companies for insurance quotes.
 - Dugouts are covered individually
 - Backstop falls under field
 - Claim history 1999, and 2017 were the last 2 claims.
 - Rob says speak with Dave Coleman (owner) from Smith Insurance as insurance claims should be looked at every couple years.
 - We are also currently insured as a Corporation not a non-profit.
 - Currently we pay \$1700 a year. Covers 12 dugouts, 20 signs and 3 buildings. 1 building is \$40,000 and the other 2 is \$120,000. Special equip \$32,000 for 2013 John Deer Tractor.
 - Jamie to scan and email the doc she has to Adam.
 - It appears that we are not covered appropriately.
 - We need to have our insurance reviewed to make it current. Adam will be reaching out to get everything up to speed and proper coverage in place.
 - The dugout needs to be taken care of, as it's a danger out there right now.
- Do we need to look at Purchasing a fence for \$40,000 for Diamond 7?
 - Discussion: Tournaments would help to pay for new

fencing if regulations allow.

- With uncertainty of broken dugout, and maintenance, we may not be able to afford the fence this season.
- 1 treatment for weeds might need to be something we are going to look at. It's roughly about \$3000.00. We generally treat Spring and Fall. Tru Green suggested at least do the Spring treatment. (we have been using them the last 3 years)
 - Pat suggested that we have the fields treated.
 - Rob suggested doing a price check and asking a few other companies.
 - Action Item: Dan to ask Pat to get a few more quotes then make a decision at the next meeting.
