• League/Operations

- Introductions of council
- New rules 6 run rule and add 5 min after hour, no feedback, no issues.
- Up to 75% of games played all 7 innings (not counting mercies),
 up from 69% last year with 7 run rule.
- Dave has feedback from players people with kids would like to be closer to the playground, especially diamond 2. Teams to be rotated to use the closer diamonds.
- Playoffs great feedback, will continue next year. Didn't do crossover series this year.



Swag still coming – will get at spring AGM.

• <u>Facilities/Projects</u>

- Hope to get Diamond 7 up and running next season, got delayed this year. Will be weather dependent, need grass to grow.
 Players can kick people off if you see people on there as nobody should be on it yet. May have to seed and water ourselves next year.
- Work done at end of season when tournaments finally ended: permanent foul lines done – 6 inches wide with shale, also worked on the infields to soften them up (will require regular maintenance). Infield got very hard last year, got a couple of quotes, will try to do more next year.
- Talks with city to talk about parking lot: more parking, paving it, etc. This will be a few years down the road.
- o If bike park goes in there will be a bathroom put in
- League wants input taken into consideration with the city.
- Alyssa and Adam talk to the city regularly and will continue to do so.

Finance

- Budget for next year projected based on what happened this year.
- Quickbooks used for accounting.
- Stated adding more categories to track exact expenses.
- Costs of everything going up
- Sitting at \$28,000 currently but that doesn't account for swag or bond cheques yet.
- Goal is to have \$20,000 reserve.
- Don't expect to do extra upgrades next year like this year, just regular maintenance. This year we spent a lot on upgrades.

- TeamSnap and Facebook will continue to be used.
- Most people got messages, less requests for help this year.
- Wanted to enter score in team snap, but issue with TeamSnap at beginning of year.
- Lots of people not entering scores still
