

# Notice of Public Meeting

To be held by CarbonFree Fort Frances Ltd. (CarbonFree) regarding a Proposal to Engage in a Renewable Energy Project

**Project Name:** CarbonFree Fort Frances

**Project Location:** The unincorporated Township of Miscampbell immediately north of the Township of Alberton, approximately 7.5 km northwest of Fort Frances, Ontario.

Following up on the first Public Meeting held in September 2025, this Second Public Meeting will afford the surrounding community an opportunity to review the detailed project proposal and the environmental and engineering studies that have been completed.

CarbonFree is planning to engage in a renewable energy project in respect of which the issuance of a Renewable Energy Approval (REA) is required. The proposal to engage in the project and the project itself is subject to the provisions of the *Environmental Protection Act (Act)* Part V.0.1 and Ontario Regulation 359/09 (Regulation). This notice must be distributed in accordance with section 15 of the Regulation prior to an application being submitted and assessed for completeness by the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks.

## Project Description:

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the facility, in respect of which this project is to be engaged in, is Class 3 solar facility. If approved, this facility would have a total maximum name plate capacity of 167 MW. The project location is described in the map below.
