Dear pheasant hunter,

Please mark your calendar to attend the Annual Olton Chamber of Commerce and Agriculture Pheasant Hunt, scheduled December 3rd and 4th, 2022 here in Olton, Texas.

We are limiting our hunt in order to provide the services and fun that you have enjoyed in the past. The cost this year will be \$400 per person for the 2-day hunt. This price includes a cap, a mandatory safety and hunt rules review, and breakfast and lunch on Saturday and Sunday. Once our hunt is full, we will not accept any new participants. If I receive your registration after we are full, I will let you know immediately and give you the option of being put on the waiting list. So please register immediately to guarantee you have a spot!

A contest will be held this year for all return hunters. Whoever brings a hunter that has not hunted with us before has a chance to win a free hunt. We will also be holding raffles for various items. If any members of your group have anything that they would like to bring to donate for the raffle, we would love it. Donations in this form are tax deductible. We just need an appraised value and we will have a receipt ready for you when you register for the hunt Saturday morning. If you would like to donate an item just let us know in advance what you are bringing so we can get the word out to everyone.

PLEASE BE SURE AND SIGN ALL PAPERS, AS THIS SPEEDS UP REGISTRATION ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE HUNT.
