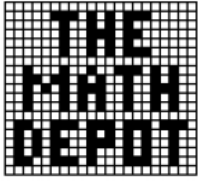

TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

REGISTRATION

All students are required to pay a non-refundable registration fee of \$25 and have a complete registration form on file. Parents / guardians must notify The Math Depot of any changes, such as phone numbers, emergency contacts, etc.

TUITION and FEES

All tuition and fees are due prior to any services being rendered. All programs and sessions must be scheduled and are by appointment only. Reservations cannot be guaranteed, and services must be paid for in advance in order to secure the space. Drop-ins are allowed based on availability. A 24-hour notice must be given to cancel and reschedule any sessions. Tuition and fees are non-refundable, but will be applied as a credit in the student's account. Students that are absent due to sickness, vacation, etc. must pay half the daily or weekly rate to hold their space in the attended program.

STUDENT ARRIVAL and PICK-UP

Students are to be brought to and picked up from The Math Depot by a parent or guardian listed on the registration form. All students must be signed-in and out by their parent / guardian for each day. Only the people listed on the student information form will be allowed to pick-up the child. A picture ID will be required. If someone other than those listed will be picking up the child, the parent / guardian must notify the center in writing. A fee of \$5 for every 10 minutes will be charged for any student that is not picked up by the end of each program or session. The Department of Family and Children Services will be contacted for any child that is not picked up an hour after the session or program ends.

COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES

Temperature Checks

Each person's temperature will be checked upon arrival. Any person with a temperature above 100F will not be allowed entry into the building. Each student's temperature must be logged in the daily sign-in form.

Masks / Face Coverings

Everyone is required to wear a mask or face covering to enter The Math Depot.

Curbside Drop-Off and Pick-Up

Parents / guardians are allowed to drop-off and pick-up their child(ren) "curbside." Parents / guardians must park at any of the parking spaces in front of The Math Depot, and call / text (404) 246 – 5367 to inform the center of their arrival.

Social Distancing

Everyone is required to maintain social distancing inside and outside The Math Depot.

Washing Hands / Sanitizing

Students are required to wash or sanitize their hands every hour.

Individual Supplies, Storage, and Space

Students are required to bring all necessary supplies to each session. Students must keep all their belongings in their designated area.

STUDENT ACTIVITY PARTICIPATION
