

Minutes of the 5/12/15 General Meeting Past-President Jim Goulette called the meeting to order (President Randall was out of town) at 7:45 PM in the parking lot of the PCYC as access to the interior of the building was unavailable after a storm. There were 14 members present, representing 10 memberships, including Board members Jim Goulette, Cheri Bauer, Kim Carless, and Al Lange. One new member family was present; No County MSBU Rep. **Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Carless gave his report, showing a balance of \$1896.66. 75 memberships have been paid through '15. An additional 43 are paid through '14, with a total of 210 on the roster. The Assn's Corp Income Tax Return, FL Corp Annual Report, and FL Short Form Income Tax Return have all been filed in a timely manner. The check register and expense log were available for review. Motion passed to accept the report. **Secretary's Report:** The minutes of the last meeting were printed in the newsletter that was sent to all members. Motion passed to accept the printed minutes. **OLD BUSINESS:** At the April MSBU meeting, the Advisory Board members were told the tip lot at 19003 Midway had been red-flagged by the County Permitting Department for any request for a dock permit. The Coast Guard would also be involved if a dock request is submitted, as the established channel takes up the majority of the canal width in this area. **NEW BUSINESS:**Past-President Goulette gave additional updates from the April MSBU Advisory Board meeting: A pre-dredge bathymetric study this summer will be put out for bids for a maintenance dredge. Final Lock Removal Loan payment will be made from MSBU funds in July. A possible reduction of the MSBU tax was proposed, and will be considered when the bathymetric study shows numbers for the maintenance dredge costs. Mr. Goulette was unaware of any additional problem areas in the canal system to be addressed in this dredge, and the study should bring some areas to our attention in the northern canals. There are already several areas with bumps in the main canals. Several members discussed local knowledge on navigating around the rocky areas between markers #6 through #10 in the Midway connector canal. The meeting adjourned for desserts at 7:53 PM.
