Recognising an ISPE Ireland Affiliate member who has demonstrated exceptional promise and impact.

All nominees should:

Be current ISPE members in good standing.

Demonstrate alignment with ISPE values and ethical standards.

Show commitment to advancing pharmaceutical and biopharmaceutical manufacturing excellence.

- Applicant/Nominee does need to be a member of the ISPE Ireland Affiliate
- Applicant/Nominee must have a Nominator

Leadership & Volunteerism	25%
Industry Impact	30%
Mentoring & Development of Others	20%

The **ISPE Ireland Member of the Year Award** is open to members at all career stages, from **emerging leaders to experienced industry professionals**. The award recognises individuals who have made a meaningful contribution to ISPE Ireland through leadership, volunteerism, professional achievements, and support for the development of others.

Applicants should provide clear examples of their contributions and impact during the award period, demonstrating commitment to the Affiliate, the Life Sciences community, and the advancement of industry excellence.

Applications will be assessed in the context of the nominee's career stage, ensuring equal recognition for both emerging talent and established professionals. The strongest submissions will provide specific examples, evidence of impact, and demonstrate alignment with the values and mission of ISPE Ireland.

- Development of resources, guidance documents, or educational content for members.
- Length and consistency of involvement with the Affiliate.
- Evidence of measurable impact on Affiliate growth, visibility, or member experience.

SECTION 2 – LEADERSHIP & VOLUNTEERISM (25%)

What applicants should include:

- Leadership roles held within ISPE Ireland or the wider Life Sciences community.
- Volunteer activities undertaken beyond normal job responsibilities.
- Examples of taking initiative, driving projects, or solving challenges.
- Contribution of personal time and expertise to support ISPE activities.
- Demonstration of collaboration, teamwork, and community-building.

SECTION 3– INDUSTRY IMPACT (30%)

What applicants should include:

- Contributions that have positively influenced the pharmaceutical or biopharmaceutical industry.
- Professional achievements that demonstrate excellence or innovation.
- Technical presentations, publications, or thought leadership activities.
- Contributions to improving manufacturing, patient outcomes, quality, compliance, or sustainability.
- Recognition received from industry peers or organisations.

SECTION 3– MENTORING AND DEVELOPEMNT OF OTHERS (20%)

What applicants should include:

- Mentoring of students, graduates, early-career professionals, or peers.

- Evidence of helping others achieve professional growth or career progression.
