# Tuesday Night League at Baker <br> TEAM EVENT <br> Pink Ball 

## RuLES AND InFORMATION

- FORMAT: Play as a team. Each team will be given 1 pink ball that must be played throughout the entire round. The pink ball is to be played and rotated throughout the foursome during the round.
a. On each hole, two net scores are combined to create one team score. One of those scores is from the designated person playing the "pink ball" for that hole. The second score used is the lowest net ball of the other three players on the team.
b. The player playing the pink ball is designated prior to teeing off on each hole.
c. Every player must play the pink ball at least twice tee to green. One golfer will need to play the pink ball three times.
d. If a team loses the pink ball (e.g. woods or water) they are disqualified from the event. Please indicate on your scorecard which hole you lost the pink ball for tie breaker purposes.

NO GIMME PUTTS ALLOWED.

- SCORING: Best net score of the pink ball + the lowest net score from the other three golfers. Add the two net scores together for each hole. If less than 4 pink balls are returned after the round, tiebreaker will be determined by who played the most holes with the pink ball.
- LESS THAN FOUR PLAYERS:
a. If your team is a 3 some, each player must play the pink ball three times.
b. Teams with fewer than three players are not eligible for prize money.
c. As usual in our league special events, to be eligible for prize money, all teams must have at least three players from the official league roster.
- PLAYERS WITHOUT HANDICAPS: Use a handicap from a previous league/club or fairly estimate your 9-hole handicap. Your estimated handicap should be the number of strokes over par on a better-than-average round.
- TIES will be broken using a scorecard playoff starting with the first hole played.
- AFTER YOUR ROUND: Turn in your scorecards and your pink ball to the event coordinator following the round.
- RULES: USGA, local rules, and league rules apply.
