

THE IMPORTANCE OF HER BIRTH, HER HOLY NAME AND HER PRECIOUS TEARS

As we journey back to look at Mary's birth we look upon her mother, St. Ann. We reflect upon how she knew that Mary was chosen and would suffer. When we look at the Book of "The Poem of the Man God" this is what is said when she is born.

Ann smiles at one of her thoughts, "She is the Star", she says. "Her sign is in Heaven. Mary arch of peace! Mary pure moon! Mary our pearl!" The woman asks, "Are you calling Her Mary?" Ann replies, "Yes"! Mary star and pearl and light and peace..." The woman replies, "But it means also bitterness...Are you not afraid of bringing her misfortune?"

Ann replies, "God is with her. She belongs to Him before She existed. He will lead Her along His ways, and all bitterness will turn into Heavenly honey. Now be of Your Mummy...for a little longer before being all of God.

How beautiful are the words of St. Ann to enlighten us that Mary was chosen by God to suffer.

As we ponder the Holy Name of Mary this is what is said about Her name in the Mystical City of God by Venerable Mary of Agreda: The holy angels heard a voice from the throne speaking in the person of the Father: "Our Chosen One shall be called "MARY", and this name is to be powerful and magnificent. Those that shall invoke it with devout affection shall receive most abundant graces; those that shall honor it and pronounce it with reverence shall be consoled and vivified and will find in it the remedy of their evils, the treasurers for their enrichment, the light which shall guide them to Heaven. It shall be terrible against the power of hell, it shall crush the head of the serpent, and it shall win glorious victories over the princes of hell.

As we journey forward and contemplate the Sorrows of Mary, she is often presented either as standing beneath the Cross, or as holding the lifeless body of Jesus on her lap, her heart transfixed by seven swords, as foretold in the prophesy of Holy Simeon at the presentation: "Thy own soul a sword shall pierce."

The Sorrowful & Immaculate Heart of Mary is a very deep and profound love that we all need to cultivate in our own hearts. I have been very blessed in my own life to have such a beautiful love of the heart of Mother Mary. Jesus and Mother Mary have brought me so deeply into their most sacred hearts, wounds, tears and sufferings which amazes me and how I treasure this most intimate gift. Jesus loves it when we shed tears for His sufferings but the tears that we shed for His Mother is even more precious to Him and He tells us so:

Jesus himself tells Blessed Veronica of Binasco, "My daughter, the tears which you shed in compassion for My sufferings are pleasing to Me, but bear in mind that on account of My excessive love for My Mother, the tears you shed in compassion for her sufferings are still more precious." Did we just hear what Jesus has told us? He loves when we contemplate his sufferings, but because of His excessive Love for His Mother, the tears that you shed in compassion for HER SUFFERINGS ARE STILL MORE PRECIOUS. So, our tears can be united to her tears, Our sufferings to her sufferings.

When we enter Our Mother Mary's heart this is a special and unique encounter. Are we taking the time to enter Mary's heart? St. Therese of the child Jesus tells us, "The loveliest masterpiece of the Heart of God is the love of a Mother." Are we standing at the Cross and looking through Her Eyes and Heart? Our Mother Mary who gave birth without labor pains would experience the greatest labor pain under the cross. Giving birth to the church. Why did Mary have to suffer so much? Because God wanted Her heart to expand so it could hold all the love, he wanted to give her and the only way that could be done was through suffering. Mother Angelica tell us, "A Mother's vocation is complete when she freely gives her child to God." We need to be open, allowing the Lord to cut and expand our hearts so that we can hold all the love that he wants to give us in the same way.

The center of civilization is the Mother and her child or there will be no civilization. Mother's, Women, Spiritual or Maternal Mothers have the capacity and can more easily communicate with God in the highest level of communion which is always through Calvary. St. Teresa of Jesus tells us, "Women are the key to our culture because they are they guardians of Purity."

As we contemplate and quiet down our souls let us open our hearts, unite our tears, and enter Her heart and tears and journey with Mary to Golgotha wiping away her tears from her eyes. Amen.
