## **Personal** Hygiene Bags

These personal hygiene bags can be given to an individual with some basic needs. Each 2-gallon zip lock bag should have the following items:

Soap	Toothpaste and toothbrush

Washcloth	Disposable razors
Deodorant	Small pack of tissues or wipes
Shampoo and conditioner	Antibiotic ointment and
Skin lotion	Band-aid
