

**VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGTON
ORDINANCE NO. 2025-02**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER V (FIVE) ENTITLED "FINANCE AND TAX"
TO ADD SECTION 5.06 ENTITLED "CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION BY
ASSESSOR" TO THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE.**

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Bloomington, Grant County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section I: Chapter V (Five) entitled "Finance and Tax", to add Section 5.06 entitled "Confidentiality of Information by Assessor" to the Village of Bloomington Municipal Code as follows:

5.06 CONFIDENTIALITY OF INFORMATION BY ASSESSOR

(1) Whenever the Assessor, in the performance of the Assessor's duties, requests or obtains income and expense information, the information that is provided to the Assessor shall be held by the Assessor on a confidential basis, except, however, that the information may be revealed to and used by persons: in the discharge of duties imposed by law; in the discharge of duties imposed by office (including, but not limited to, use by the Assessor in performance of official duties of the Assessor's office and use by the Board of Review in performance of its official duties); or pursuant to a court order. Income and expense information provided to the Assessor under Wis. Stat. §70.47(7)(af), unless a court determines that it is inaccurate, is, per Wis. Stat. §70.47(7)(af), not subject to the right of inspection and copying under Wis. Stat. §19.35(1).

(2) Severability. The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.

Section II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication or posting as required by law.
