PSC Bulk Water Rate Reference

Per PSC Schedule BW-1, all bulk water supplied through hydrants or other connections must be metered or estimated by the utility. Utility personnel or an approved party must supervise delivery.

Charges include:

- \$15.00 Bulk Water Service Charge
- Volumetric charge based on the highest residential rate under Schedule Mg-1
- Current first-tier residential rate: \$7.65 per 1,000 gallons

Liability / Hold Harmless Agreement

The applicant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Village of Bloomington, its municipal water utility, employees, officials, and agents from any claims, damages, losses, or liabilities arising from the use of hydrants, water connections, or Village property while obtaining bulk water.

The Village shall not be responsible for damage to vehicles, tanks, pumps, hoses, or related equipment used during water withdrawal operations.

The Village reserves the right to revoke bulk water authorization for safety violations, non-payment, or misuse of hydrants or equipment.
