Contractor's Schedule (items started/completed):

- Most all sanitary sewer on Spruce Road and Wall Street is complete.
- Most all water main on Spruce Road and Wall Street is complete.
- Storm sewer is about 50% complete on Spruce Road and Wall Street.

Contractor's Schedule (two-week outlook):

- Week of September 9th
 - o Monday continue storm sewer installation on Wall Street.
 - o Tuesday continue storm sewer installation on Spruce Road.
 - Wednesday pending safe sample, replace water services.
 - o Thursday complete sanitary sewer installation on Spruce Road.
 - Friday complete installation of water main on Spruce Road and Wall Street. (possible scheduled water shutoff for connection to existing water main (once exact date is known, residents/businesses will be notified)
- Week of September 16th
 - Complete water main installation on Spruce Road and Wall Street/Canal Street intersection.
 - Possible scheduled water shutoffs this week for connections to existing water main (once exact dates are known, residents/businesses will be notified)
 - Begin street excavation on Spruce Road and Wall Street.
 - o Begin water main installation on Canal Street.

Utility Relocation:

- TDS and Charter Communications have utility relocations that need to be completed.
 - Possible service interruptions may occur and affected individuals will be notified by the respective utility company prior to the interruption.

Traffic Control:

- Please continue to follow road closed/traffic control signage.
- Flagging operations will need to be done at the intersection of Spruce Road and Canal Street.
 - Between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm the contractor has full use of areas under construction (except for emergency vehicles). Between these hours, property owners will not have guaranteed access to/from their property. Please plan accordingly.

Surveying:

- Delta 3 Engineering has staked with pink flags and wooden hubs, the sanitary sewer, water main, and storm sewer on Wall Street and Spruce Road.
 - Please do not disturb these markers.
- Also please do not disturb markers/flags for gas (yellow), electrical (red), fiber (orange), and telecommunication (orange).
