
Good Reading!

Faith Amidst the Storm

Matthew 14:26-30

"And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, 'It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.'

And Peter answered Him and said, 'Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.' And He said, 'Come.' And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water to go to Jesus. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, 'Lord, save me.' And immediately Jesus stretched forth His hand, and caught him, and said unto him, 'O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?'

At first, Peter did not even notice the high winds and the boisterous waves. He only recognized his Lord and stepped out in recognition of Him and walked on the water. When he began to notice what was actually happening, and the things going on around him, 'down he went instantly.' It is the same with us as we step out on God over some things. When we look at

actual things, we become overwhelmed and take our eyes off the Lord. When we fail to see Jesus in the midst of our storms, it is because we are looking at the storm, instead of maintaining complete reliance on Him. If we debate or regress for one second when God has spoken, we too begin to sink. Let actual circumstances be what they may. Keep recognizing Jesus and maintain complete reliance on Him. If you doubt or debate for one second when God has spoken, you begin to feel abandoned. Do you know 'His Voice'? Can you recognize 'His Voice'? Pray for the recognition of 'His Voice,' so that you will never feel abandoned. The world is going through some tough times, and we will all be affected in one way or another. In the book of Jeremiah, God promised Jeremiah that He would deliver him personally, and we have that same promise. Do not look around or be frightened by the crashing waves. Devote yourself fully in Prayer because Jesus says, 'Go steadily on with what I have told you to do, and I will guard your life,' and 'Lean not on your own understanding."
