

GEA UNIFORM POLICY

DRESS CODE/PERSONAL APPEARANCE

As a Christian School, we have a unique opportunity in our community. We should have a desire to attract others to Christ in every aspect of our lives, including our dress. **Modesty is our standard.** All clothing must be clean, properly fitted, and neat in appearance. As such, beginning the 2026-2027 school year, G.E.A. will begin **reinforcing school uniforms.** The school colors are burgundy and gold. Polo shirts can either be burgundy or yellow. Bottoms can be shorts, slacks, skorts, skirts, jumpers, etc., in khaki, black, or navy. Dress should not distract from the learning process, **nor should it attract undue attention to one's appearance.** In addition to honoring the Lord, students' attire should convey respect for themselves and the GEA community. **Parents are requested to review the dress code and assist the school in its implementation.** During Halloween, if students feel the need to wear a costume, **it should be a biblical character.**

Male Students

- All clothing needs to fit appropriately and be worn modestly
- Single-color polo-style shirts with or without a school logo must be worn on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. A white Oxford-style shirt with short or long sleeves and a burgundy tie must be worn on Wednesday.
- Dress slacks, casual slacks, or uniform shorts may be worn to school. Pants and shorts must be worn at normal waist height and not at the hips. All must be worn with a belt.
- Knee-length shorts are permitted, including Athletic shorts.
- Sneakers worn with socks are the best footwear for school. Shoes must be closed-toed and heeled. Cowboy boots and flip-flops are not appropriate for school unless it is a special dress-up day, as named by the administration.

Female Students

- All clothing needs to fit appropriately and be worn modestly.
- The length of dresses or skirts must be near the top of the knee when standing. It is strongly recommended that girls wear bike shorts or something similar under dresses/skirts.
- Dress slacks, casual pants, skirts, and skorts are to be worn daily as part of the uniform.
- Leggings, ballet pants, and yoga pants are not acceptable for school
- Knee-length shorts are permitted, including Athletic shorts.
- Blouses are to be single-color polo style on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday with the school logo.
- Sneakers worn with socks are the best footwear for school. Shoes must be closed-toed, with at least a strap around the heel. Cowboy boots and flip-flops are not appropriate for school, except for a special dress-up day, as named by the administration.
