The Doug Eyink Memorial Scholarship for Alternative Strings will award the following each year:

1. In memory of, and respect for, all his years of dedication to building this program, the Doug Eyink Memorial Scholarship for Alternative Strings will award the sum of \$200 to the **Centerville Alternative Strings Program** for use as the director sees fit, including the purchase of music, strings, accessories, repairs, travel, and anything deemed necessary by their director without any further permission from the board.
2. The board will provide support, upon request and discussion, to the director of the **Centerville Alternative Strings Program** that will promote the professional development of the Centerville Alternative Strings Director. Example, lessons or help with tuition for a summer camp, etc.
3. The **Graduating Senior Scholarship**. The Doug Eyink Memorial Scholarship for Alternative Strings will award one \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating senior who meets all application criteria.
4. The **Junior Summer Camp Scholarship**. The Doug Eyink Memorial Scholarship for Alternative Strings will award one \$500 Scholarship to a High School Junior who meets all application criteria for use toward summer camp.

The board has determined the following guidelines for distribution of funds from the Doug Eyink Memorial Scholarship for Alternative Strings. The decision of the board regarding assignment of scholarship funds is absolute.

1. Scholarship candidates will be a senior or junior depending on scholarship for which they apply, and will reside and go to school in the Greater Dayton area, specifically in Clark, Greene, and Montgomery counties.
2. Candidates will have achieved a 3.0 or higher GPA.
3. Candidates will provide two letters of recommendation (one must be from a music teacher-public or private) attesting to their musical ability and character. Suggested references include teachers, scout leaders, coaches, employers, or religious leaders who are acquainted with both musical achievements and personal character i.e. responsibility, reliability, and the like.
4. Candidates will provide a three-minute video recording of a musical performance that demonstrates their level of performance.
5. Candidates will submit applications no later than May 9, 2025.
