Abstract: Libraries have a long tradition of celebrating identities and cultures, often collaborating with campus partners on special events, exhibits, or lectures. In recognition of National Deaf History Month, the library engaged in a year-long partnership with the university's American Sign Language & Deaf Studies (ASLDS) department. The

collaboration culminated in three exhibits: a materials selection framework, a student-selected library acquisitions project, and an ASL storytime. This presentation will detail the successful library-department partnership and highlight the project's diverse contributors, ranging from a facility and a student organization to the Center for

Inclusive Excellence and the University's preschool. Inherent in the project's structure and outcomes, too, is a strategic, all-hands approach to engagement beyond the confines of liaison librarianship. Presenters from the library and the ASLDS department faculty will discuss the project components, share strategy, ,and reflect on outcomes.

Additionally, presenters will lead session participants through an interactive exercise to draft an outreach project engagement strategy.
