The Protest Is Loud, But the Mind Behind It Is the Same

Everywhere you look in America, someone is protesting something. They are either protesting police brutality, ICE, politicians, the system, the government, and/or the people in power. And yet, for all the shouting, all the marching, all the bullhorns raised in the air, one thing has not changed, which is the following: the people, who are doing the protesting, are shaped by the same culture as the people who they are protesting against. That is the part that nobody wants to

admit. In other words, we say the police need reform. We say the government needs reform. We even say the system needs reform. But the truth is deeper than that, which is, the American mind needs reform. Because if all of us are shaped by the same culture, then replacing one group with another does not fix anything; it just rotates the same mentality into a different seat. I have watched people demand that officers be fired, but what they do not realize is this:

If the tree is sick, every apple that you pick will

taste the same.”

In other words, you can fire an officer, but the replacement grew up in the same environment. You can vote out a politician, but the next one was raised by the same culture. You can defund a department, but the people still live in the same society. This is why nothing changes.

The Problem Is Not the Badge. It Is the Culture That Raised the Person Wearing It.

I remember watching the footage of those Black officers in Tennessee who were beating that young Black man. People were shocked; nevertheless, I was not, because when you stripped the uniform off, they did not look like trained professionals. They looked like gang members. Not because of their race. Not because of their job. But because of their mentality. And that mentality did not come from the police academy. It came from

America. In other words, it came from the movies that we celebrate, the music that we glorify, the sports that we cheer for, the conversations that we normalize, the entertainment that we consume without blinking et cetera. This country trains people to enjoy violence long before it trains them to enforce the law. Therefore, when someone joins the police force, they do not suddenly become violent; they simply bring the American mindset with them. And here is the part that stings: The protesters share the same mindset. They may be fighting for justice, but they were shaped by the same culture of aggression, competition, and self-interest. So, even if they replaced the officers or the politicians, they would repeat the same mistakes; not because they are bad people, but because they were raised the same way. This is why defunding the police does not work, firing officers does not work, and replacing leaders does not work, because

the mind has not changed.

“You cannot change how a person lives until you change how they think.”

And America has never addressed the thinking.

A Nation Cannot Be Repaired Until Its Mind Is Renewed

Romans 12:2 gives the only solution that actually works:

“Be transformed by the renewing of your mind.”

In other words, you cannot change a nation for the better by defunding, by protesting, by replacing, by destroying, by shouting through a bullhorn, but by renewing the mind, because the real crisis in America is not the government; it is the culture that shapes the people who run it. Look at our schools. Every activity that brings students together is a competition. Not one popular program teaches cooperation, compassion, or community.

We train children to win instead of teaching them to work together. We teach them to focus on themselves instead of each other. Then we are surprised when adults cannot uphold peace. We are surprised when officers act like fighters. We are surprised when leaders act like competitors instead of servants. But why are we surprised? This is the same country that treats violence as entertainment. We outlaw fighting in the streets, but we sell tickets to watch people beat each other in a ring. We call it a sport. We call it entertainment. We call it harmless. But the ancient proverb already warned us:

“They have made a sport out of mischief.”

And when a nation makes a sport with violence, it should not be shocked when violence shows up in its police force, its politics, its protests, and its people. This is why America needs more than reform. It needs more than new laws. It

needs more than new leaders.
America needs a renewed
mind. America needs revival.
America needs Romans 12:2,
because until we change the
culture that shapes the mind,
we will keep producing the
same behavior; no matter who
wears the badge, who holds
the office, or who carries the
bullhorn. And that is why I
speak the way that I do. That
is why I stepped away from the
system. That is why I promote
renewal over rebellion.
Because a renewed mind does
not just change a person; it
changes a nation ... Amen!
