

# 1 CORINTHIANS 9:24-27

How is it that the best school in America with the highest percentage of graduation have mostly white students, and schools with the highest percentage of dropout rate have mostly black students? That was a rhetorical question, which is not expecting an answer, but to bring awareness to the problem with violence in the Black community, and the worst schools in America are intentionally in the Black community. This is self-evident, that is, this is evidence in itself without proof or demonstration that the worst schools are in the Black community.

White schools are designed and structured for every student to reach graduation, while black schools are designed to weed out students via competition, e.g., every activity at black schools is designed for black boys to interact with each other in a competitive way, and there is not one program in schools for black boys to have interaction with each other, which train and teach them to work together; moreover, Black students who are not with the program, or cannot compete to keep up are driving away.

I joined the Navy in the hope of escaping this violent environment in the Black community; moreover, I learned an important lesson about discrimination in boot camp. Every activity in training and school was designed to teach us to work together. I further my research of white people, and I learned that white people create a lot of programs to teach their kids to work together, be leaders and business owners who are responsible to lead their people, create jobs for them

to provide a way to serve each other, and give enough money to them to take care of themselves and their families. They are taught to not just take care of their family, but also their people, while Blacks boys are lucky to learn to look out for family; nevertheless, they are not taught in school to be responsible for their people, which is why black students do not graduate from college then create careers in the Black community like White kids who create careers in the white community. So why black people take pride in their college education instead of protesting about how these Colleges (including the Black Colleges) have not adequately educate, train, and prepare them to function in America like white people.

Notice how there is a higher rate of black boys to graduate from school and be successful in sport than in anything other fields combine together, and the attention in the Black communities is only center around sport to focus on sport and entertaining each other instead of leading us daily to come together to work to help each other to meet each other needs. White people, Asia people, Spanish people, people from India etc. do not excel in sport like Blacks, because their focus is to center first around building an economy to sustain their people, which distribute needs to their people daily. Therefore, sport players are not the richest in their community. The richest men are responsible for building jobs for their people, providing a way to provide vital service to each other, which is where they are taught to direct their attention towards building each other up; therefore, Black people like me might hate Donald Trump for being racist, but we are blind to the reason why a lot of white people

are loyal to him. It has nothing to do with racism. White people are obligated to honor and protect white men who they feel they owe them for creating a life for them. Therefore, they are ready to sacrifice their life for them without asking them to say, "thank you for what you have done for our people". I respect the reason for their loyalty to Donald Trump, and I simultaneously disrespect their loyalty to him, because white people govern America for their people to function around their men like this, and everyone else must work for them instead of allowing us to raise our own Black leaders to lead us in the same manner. Therefore, there is a racist conspiracy to support the sport players in the Black community instead of the Black men who really care about us, and know how to organize us to work to build our community to thrive as white communities. The White man see the Black man from America as more of a threat than other people, because we are the only ones who fight effectively against the racist machination of white people to establish them as superior to other Americans instead of governing America with equality. These rich white men do not consider Blacks as American and equal to them. You can tell, because they do not feel responsible to share the wealth of America with blacks and provide good jobs for Blacks. They only provide these jobs to their people and other people who bow to them as superior to their people. FACEBOOK owner, Bill Gates, Donald Trump, Warren Buffett etc. never come to the black community to build jobs here like in white community. They treat us like America is at war with us. We are all Americans when it comes time to work and go to war together, but they acknowledge us as Black (that is, difference) when it comes

time to share the wealth after helping them to build the wealth of America. Not only will they not share the wealth, but there is a conspiracy to make sure that we stay poor.

For example, notice how America sanction Russia, the Iranian, and North Korea to prevent resources from entering these countries, and the white man support country that acknowledge the white men in America as superior. The white man is at war with us, too, for no apparent reason, because we are not a threat to the sovereignty of America, we are not anti-America, or hate America. We help these white people to win wars, build America, speak, learn and teach their language, and support every aspect of America. Yet they have sanctioned the black communities like they did the enemies of America. Yet they do not sanction us for being anti-America, but anti-racism.

I am a veteran. One of my best qualities that the white man say about me is that I serve this country without going against any order that America gave to me. I also have an honorable discharge. Yet white people will not dedicate their lives to me like I dedicate my life to this country. I could have died on the dangerous missions in South America to help them to fight drug cartels, and they sent me on a war tour to fight against terrorists in the middle east. Do you think that they are thankful for my service to this country. No! They always say, "thank you for your service", but never really show it by giving the same service back to me. What is a free lunch at the VA hospital, free tickets to see the Dodger, housing homeless Black veteran, and helping us to meet just our basic needs. Black Veterans deserve more from this country. We need rights and opportunities to have more than

just our basic needs, but to have the same opportunity, resources, and help from them to build our communities, which distribute the wealth to all Americans instead of to just White people. They say that Black people are asking for a handout by asking for Food Stamp, SSI or any other government assistances. Now this money is distributed to us from taxes, right; however, what the white man do not discuss is that most of the taxes are distributed to white people. Not only do white people get more government assistance than the black community, but government assistance is also the most vital resources in these rich white communities. Whenever these white people are in trouble, the government always bell them out with government assistance, and the government is constantly giving government grants and other types of assistance to White people to sustain their community, which is a form of government assistance.

This competitive system developed black boys to be aggressive (that is, it raises them to approach others with unprovoked violence as a mean to accomplish their goal and to get what they want), have angry and violent issues, because sport train and teaches you to use violent efforts towards others in the name of fun, to be number one, the champion etc. ... therefore, Black boys grow up loving violent, and being violent when not provoked. They learn this behavior in public schools. Yet we will blame kids for being violent instead of taking the responsibility of raising them to be violent. In other words, these public schools do not teach Black boys to work together to help each other; they only teach them to use violent effort or compete in other ways to help yourself. And we wonder why we have this attitude of every Black man for

himself. This is a learned behavior in the Black Community, because most of my childhood male friends was some of the gentlest, loving, caring, and sharing person who I have ever met. As a matter of fact, this is the main reason why I miss them. Yet, we begin to change. Home was not the problem, because, again, parents in the Black community, which I was raised in, were sending their kids to school who were so decent, had high hope, and caring. Yet they left school as different people. We had to focus more on learning to fight than learning the lessons in books, because of the problem of intentionally not stopping bullying in public school, and focusing more on sport than education. I do not see how Black people in my generation send their kids to a public school after our horrible experience. They know that public school is a waste of our time. We all love the ideal of school to educate us but hated the experience at public schools. We were better off by dropping out of school in middle school to avoid the horrible experience in high school, which was a big distraction.

Nevertheless, for argument's sake, let's say that the school in the Black community is right by saying, "the school is not the problem; the problem is the students and their parents". Now let us observe their solution for dealing with troubled students. Their solution is to expel the troubled students from school. This is not a punishment for a kid but a reward. The kid is like maybe I should have gotten into trouble sooner, because I do not want to be in this crazy school, anyway. When we expel a kid from school, this does not solve the problem, but gets rid of the problem. The problem still exists. Guess what the problem student is doing



away from school. Getting into more trouble! Now we are forced to deal with them when we could have approached this problem in a different way in the beginning to prevent it from escalating and spiraling out of control. The last thing that a school should do is expel a student. Schools should do the opposite. School should put troubled students under more supervision of being monitored by more staff at school to correct their behavior, because guess who grows up from being a troubled student to a criminal. The student that is expelled. These people in school got a degree; so, they know this already, which bring us back to their true reason for expelling Black students ... their reason is just that. Expel them, which means, "to drive them away from school". They need to investigate also how these teachers are intentionally making Black male to feel uncomfortable who are not a problem in school, which cause them to quit. Mission accomplishes ... they do not want us in school, working environment, or the public to prosper, anyway.

Therefore, Black boys are victims of an adverse circumstance at these public schools. There is no excuse to justify violence unless for self-defense. Yet we justify kids to using violence to hurt each other in sport in the name of fun. We know that violence is wrong. Yet we teach, train, and encourage boys to be violent via participation in these violent sports. Consequently, again, our kids are not learning to work together to help each other; on and to the contrary, they educate these Black boys to advance with violent efforts to get what they want, and to be on top. Since they are taught to make one's way in life with violent efforts, it is obviously that school focus more on sport than education, because America

has more successful black men as millionaire in sport than in any other fields combine together. Only a fool will run in a race with a distance of never reaching the end of the race, which is exactly the race for the black man in America, because it is impossible to finish first forever in a competitive system. This type of system is designed to eventually wear you down, exhaust you, and become a loser, because even the best will eventually lose. No one can stay on top forever in a competitive system, but we can all stay on top via the system of Love. So, we must educate these black boys to help each other instead of competing in school, which will end this problem with homelessness, and seeing so many beat down black men in society with no support from their own community.

By the way, did you know that 98% of the Black men, who graduated from school and became a millionaire, play sport, and less than 1% of the Black men who graduated from school have a business to circulate millions back into the black community? Why black businesses do not protest against these sport players for not circulating their wealth back into the black community instead of advertising these sport players in our community. This is why businesses are struggling in the black community. If these so-called educated Blacks, and rich Blacks do not get together to figure out a way to circulate that money into the hand of black people instead of just asking to support black businesses, then the black community will continue to struggle economically. Black businesses are not employing Blacks, which put most of the money back, but just hiring Blacks to make minimum wages.



Yet educated Black people take pride in their education instead of protesting, since these public schools only educate black men how to make their way in this white man's world with violent effort instead of educating black men to build a business to thrive in the Black community to not just generate money but circulate 90% of the profit back into the Black community. If they don't stop leading our Black people like this, then we will continue to see Black men to not be supported in their own community unless they play sport. Black sport players would not be rich without people to watch their game, which is what makes sport profitable. So, they owe this to their people to do more ... like white men who are the owner of Facebook, Twitter, Tesla, Trump Towel, General Motor, Ford, Microsoft, Dell Computer, Apple products etc.; they only keep 10% of the profit, and the rest goes back into businesses to help grow the economy in White community and to circulate the money by hiring others to make millions, too. Here is where it gets racist. The black man got to use violent effort in sport to make millions coming out of school, while the white man has both options to play sport or be non-violent to make millions in their community. School is only teaching Black men to use violent effort for survival instead of teaching us to work together, which is the only way to relieve the black man of his burden; therefore, America is still creating a society to keep the black man back and struggling.

They say, "let nature runs its course"; consequently, the natural course in the Black community runs by winning a crown in sport, school, political arena, war et cetera. by

beating others. This type of race is corruptible, because to use violence other than for self-defense is unprovoked violence, which is a dishonest practice, and a dishonest way of living life, that is, to hurt others to get what you want is so corrupt. Therefore, since sport is structure to get what you want like a criminal, sport destroys the integrity of a man, because it positions you to not remain loyal to help others to win, be successful, and keep each other on top together; there is no being kind, faithful to each other, gentle, loving each other in sport, which are the fruit of the spirit. Moreover, the end of the course in sport is defeat, that is, everyone is a loser in sport, because everyone will eventually lose in sport. Yet everyone is a winner, and remains on top on the course of love, because it is impossible to lose, not win, be on top, and not be first, when no one is trying to beat you, but help you. Nothing is in your way but yourself when we love each other. For how it is possible to lose in a circumstance with love from everyone around you. My conclusion for this article (that is, dog eat dog attitude in the public schools) regarding what change the black man from that precious innocent black child is this. The Black man did not fail in school; school fail the Black man.
