## WHY FREEDOM FOR BLACK PEOPLE IS FEARED AND NOT FUNDED: THE HIDDEN LOGIC OF GLOBAL INJUSTICE

Black People in America Are Ignored While Others Are Elevated By Love

What if the reason why Black people have not received real support, reparations, or independence is not just neglect, but fear? They do not fear Black violence, Black sport players or Black entertainers; they fear Black awakening. They fear the return of dignity to those who were once called "property," because if you cannot keep a people enslaved by chains, you try to enslave them by ideas: fake freedom, low expectations, media distractions, and economic traps. And here is the deeper injustice: they use our own goodness against us. Our patience, our forgiveness, our creativity, and our ability to endure; in other words, they manipulate these gifts to keep us pacified while others are allowed to rise. When they gave land to Israel, it was a message: we will restore what we value. When they deny reparations to Black people, it is another message: we do not value you enough to restore you. But here is the spiritual truth: we are not waiting for validation from these corrupt systems. We are rising, because the truth is rising. Our claim is

not political; it is moral, spiritual, and universal. No system can forever silence what is owed to the children of those who built the world with their blood. The time has come for the illusion to collapse. True freedom is not granted—it is reclaimed.



## A Deeper Perspective of Why They Are Afraid of Us

The reason why they do not choose people with roots deep in America's slavery is because we remember too much. We remember the whip. We remember the chains. We remember the fake Emancipation, the stolen Reconstruction, the betrayals, the lynchings, and the mass incarceration. And with that

memory comes an unshakable awareness of the truth. That truth cannot be softened, it cannot be negotiated, and it sure cannot be silenced. They fear that if someone truly represents us to ever gets power, they will not use it to decorate the system. They will use it to dismantle it. That is why we are locked out, even while they point to the Black faces that they let in. But let's be clear: we are not confused. We know the difference between a brother and a buffer.



## Black Peoples in America Get a Performance of Freedom While Israel Get Real Freedom

Therefore, it is time that we speak plainly. Across Europe and America, nations are pouring their support into the

establishment of the so-called "Jews" as an independent people. They offer real freedom to them, (for example, land, power, money, military backing, and global sympathy). And the shocking part is, most of these nations were not even directly responsible for the Holocaust. Yet they still feel a moral obligation to uplift and defend these people. Meanwhile, we, the descendants of those stolen from Africa, colonized, enslaved, and dehumanized for centuries. receive no such global support. We do not get independence. We do not get freedom in its true form. We get a watered-down version of freedom in the form of an illusion. They give just enough to us to calm the masses, but never enough to break free. We are told that we are equal but still live our lives under systemic inequality. We are told that we are free, but we are still trapped in a racist system that is designed to keep us dependent and subjected to the same people who once enslaved us. Europe should feel even more responsible for us than for Israel or anyone else, because their wealth, their power, and their nations were not built

off the backs of these so-called "Jews", but off the back of our ancestors. This is not just a moral issue. It is a natural obligation, because there is a universal law that says, "you reap what you sow". But instead of reparation and justice, they give token holidays like Juneteenth, shallow speeches via Black politicians in Congress, and performative gestures to us.

They call that "freedom."

They give commemorations to us instead of compensation. They tell us to celebrate while we still mourn. They offer symbols to us while others receive substance. While others are given true freedom, we are left with a hollow word, which is freedom in name only instead of in reality. It is time that we stop accepting this. It is time to tell the world that we deserve what was stolen, we deserve what is owed, and we will no longer accept illusions in place of justice. You know what I just shared with you is deeply real, and it speaks to something that many feel but are too afraid or uncomfortable to say. Nevertheless, I did not say it with hate; I said it with truth and clarity. So let us sit with it and honor what it really means.



Chosen, But Not for Us: The Strategy Behind Black Representation

Let's be honest: America is finally willing to put Black people in high positions, but look closely, and you will see a pattern. They are not choosing those of us whose roots go deep into the blood-soaked soil of American slavery. They are choosing Black immigrants or first- and second-generation Americans who are people who may look like us, but were not shaped by the same pain, the same survival, and the same betrayal. This is not by accident. It is a strategy. They want someone who can speak to us,

but not for us. They want someone who will echo the voice of the White House instead of carrying the voice of the Black house. And since we are being real: these chosen leaders never gather us to ask, "What do you need? How do we fix this?" Instead, they appear on TV smiling, symbolic, dressed in power, but never shake the foundation of the system that still keeps us at the bottom. And when we do raise up real leaders from our own communities. those who truly speak our language and live our struggle, they either get silenced, discredited, locked up, or killed. They do not want a Frederick Douglass. They do not want a Malcolm X or a Martin Luther King. They want someone polished, manageable, and disconnected enough to keep the illusion alive: "See? You are progressing!" But progress is not a face in office; it is a freedom in reality. Representation without liberation is just camouflage. It hides the fact that we still do not have power. It keeps the world from seeing that the descendants of slavery have never been given the right to choose their own

representatives. We are only allowed to accept the ones who are chosen for them. And those chosen voices do not challenge the system; they blend into it.
