# **HOOK**

Open your Bible to the book of James. Now turn to Chapter one, verse 2 through 4. I will discuss the virtue, power and effectiveness of being patient by using the excruciating experience of my people in America. My people were deprived of an identity, rights, freedom, and the hope of these racist people to let us free; yet we persevere through the most impossible and miserable situation imaginable. We never gave up despite the difficulty, obstacles, or discouragement from White people. Allow me to play a prerecorded tape of my people to force JFK to give our rights to us, which contradicts this narrative in history books and classes of him as this good guy for fighting for us to have rights (You must click on the attached file as a video to hear and see JFK to admit that niggas in Alabama compel him and this nation to grant our rights).

The fact that John F. Kennedy did not intervene to allow us to have our rights, and prevent his people from oppressing us, killing us et cetera until after niggas to revolt in Alabama, this is self-evident of him to not make an agreement with us to stop oppressing us out of sympathy, but defeat. You must admire the irony of this situation. They thought by having us outnumber, outgun, and establishing racist laws to oppose and resist us from having equal rights would turn us into hopeless people; yet this advantage over us was hopeless and useless to stop us from overthrowing this racist nation to rule us.
