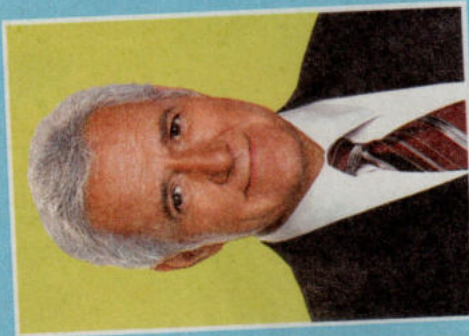

INDIA GOES DARK

Largest electrical blackout in history

About 670 million people, or 10% of world's population, affected

NEW DELHI — It had all the makings of a disaster movie: More than a half-billion people without power. Trains motionless on the tracks. Miners trapped underground. Subway lines paralyzed. Traffic snarled in much of the national capital.

On Tuesday, India suffered the largest electrical blackout in history, affecting an area encompassing about 670 million people, or roughly 10 percent of the world's population. Three of the country's interconnected northern power grids collapsed for several hours, as blackouts extended almost 2,000 miles, from India's eastern border with Myanmar to its western border with Pakistan.

For a country considered a rising economic power, Blackout Tuesday — which came only a day after another major power failure — was an embarrassing reminder of the intractable

Roof Top solar power is growing up like crazy in California. This one facilitates all house owners in a number of ways. But the big problem in California is 50% of Californian Residents are renters & monthly users like students/horticulturists but not owners, which means that nearly half the residents of the state can't purchase solar generated electricity even if they want to enjoy.

Now the solar industry, environmentalists, financiers, utilities & legislative staffers in Sacramento are hashing out an innovative but controversial senate bill that would allow people to join forces & collectively buy solar power from a shared facility.

other forms of renewable energy like WIND, BIO-MASS, Geo-Thermal & small Hydro power. But solar panels, which have seen a dramatic drop ^{in price} in recent years are expected to make up a lion's share of new projects. A Senate bill no 843 aims to bring an additional .2 gigawatts of renewable energy on line within the territories of the 3 largest utilities of the state - (PG&E, SOEC, SCE). The .2 gigawatts is nothing to sneeze at. One gigawatt is the output of 2 (Coal) power plants and gives enough energy to power 750,000 homes. The bill would allow customers of these utilities to buy renewable energy from, say, a solar array on the roof of a church or a local high school or a city hall.

The modus operandi is for the customers would sign contracts with the developers of the solar projects and pay a monthly fee for the energy they buy from them. In exchange, they would become subscribers of the project and receive a credit for their portion of the energy produced on their monthly utility bills.
