Ramesh immersion was a non-event till late 1970s (1979 to be precise, if I remember correct). Then the Visargam used to be done by a handful of Ramesh idols, with no public processions as of now. The communal riots of 1978 emanating from the pe of Rameez Bee lead to the "SAMANTHIKA VISARGAM 1980". Prior to that there were only two ^{big} processions: TOHARRAM & BONALU (mostly for women's folk of the). Thus Ramesh Visargam was started in 1980 strategically as a show of unity & strength among Hindu population of twin cities. No wonder, politics played a big role in popularising Ramesh Visargam phenomenon as an event. Over the years, the dynamics of Ramesh Immersion has changed drastically. Times have changed & human values. Now politicians preside over the Visargam proceedings, by rotation of caste as well as by age & age-wise -

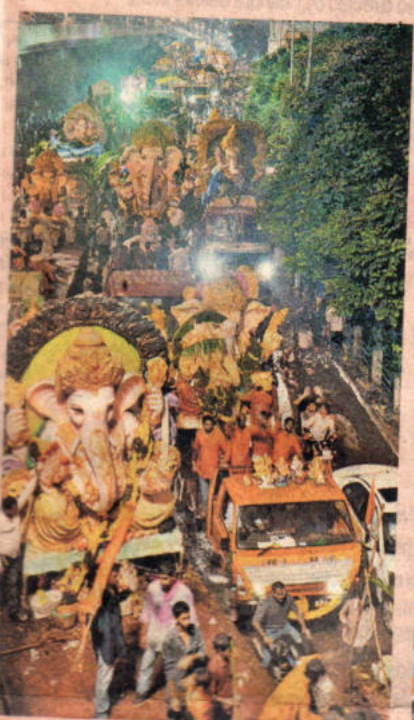
