- The ICAA is partnered with AGI and offers members exclusive pricing options on 6-Panel, color, and pattern testing, as well as DNA Profiling. Parentage verification is free on foals from parents who have been DNA Profiled.

#### The 2021 ICAA Stallion Service Auction

The auction went very well this year! We want to thank the stallion owners who donated their amazing stallions to this auction, and to the mare owners who bid on them. Remember, stallion owners are eligible for a free registration in 2021 or 2022 for each stallion donated.

There will be a few changes next year for bidders, in order to be sure only legitimate bids being placed, and for the bidders to fully understand that their bids are a contract.



## ANIMAL, GENETICS (AGI) CHANGE OF ADDRESS

While we were aware that AGI was in the process of building a new facility and would be moving, it came to our attention that they had actually completed this move quite some time ago, and we were not aware of this change.
