
Many of our horses have pedigrees full of the old ApHC foundation horses, but there are some that do not. ICAA has a place for most Appaloosas with documented pedigrees. Whether your horse has only one generation of registered Appaloosas (both parents) or many, there is a place for you to begin your endeavor to support and/or produce 8+ generation Purebred horses. We will also accept qualifying geldings with unknown or other breed parents allowing owners to support ICAA and compete in ICAA programs.

ICAA is a stand-alone registry. Once the parents have been registered with ICAA, their offspring need not be registered in any other registry as the parent's pedigrees have already been documented

We are the first stock horse breed registry that is striving for a genetically clean registry. Testing for genetic defects as well as DNA Profiling and Parentage Verification is a requirement for registration. These requirements enable ICAA to be a reputable and elite registry.

ICAA Programs

ICAA offers a number of competitive & noncompetitive Programs for membership involvement.

- <u>Open Show Point Program</u> Compete in Open, Breed and/or ApHC events to earn points and compete for Year End Awards.
- <u>Distance Program</u> Compete in Endurance and Competitive Trail events and earn Year End Awards.
- <u>Horsemanship Program</u> For those who want to log the time they spend with their Appaloosas in non-competitive activities.
- <u>Production Achievement Awards</u> For mares and stallions producing a specific number of colored foals.





BCA Yamas Noctiluca (F7) One of only a few documented 7-generation Appaloosas fillies in the world.
