UPDATED INFORMATION ON Shrub Trimming

Clusia (Pitch Apple) Hedge Trimming

BrightView Tree has been working through the property to evaluate the condition of the Clusia hedges and, in some areas, make necessary heavier cuts to restore their structure and long-term health. Over time, certain sections have become excessively top-heavy, creating structural concerns and increasing the potential for limbs or sections of the hedge to fail during periods of high winds. Upcoming storms or hurricanes may by damage or weaken portions of the plants. While these cuts are necessary, residents may notice that some areas of the hedge appear uneven or more heavily trimmed than others in the short term.

As the Clusia responds and begins to put on new growth, our regular maintenance crews will continue to work these areas during their normal trimming cycles. This will allow us to gradually shape and balance the hedges while encouraging stronger, more uniform growth. Our goal is not simply to make the hedges look uniform immediately, but to address the underlying structural issues and establish healthier, more manageable hedges that can be maintained consistently over time. We appreciate everyone's patience as these areas recover and the hedge lines are brought back into a more balanced appearance.
