POOL HEATER

We have had several inquiries regarding the heater repairs for the Island Club Pool so, we want to take this opportunity to explain what has happened and the status of the repair.

- The pool heater was completely submerged in water during Hurricane Ian
- For the first couple of weeks following the storm, vendors had no availability to come out to look at the situation
- Once a repair vendor came onsite to look, they stated that the control panel needed to be replaced before they could fully diagnose the issue. They ordered the panel and this took about a week and a half to arrive. It has since been installed
- After the control panel installation, it was discovered that the motor was destroyed and a new one needed to be ordered. We ordered two so that we have a backup in the future
- We have been following up daily with the vendor to get the status of the motor. They state that it "should" arrive early next week and as soon as it arrives, they will be on site to install it

We know how important the Island Club Pool is to the community and sincerely apologize for the frustration and inconvenience.

GENERAL REPAIRS

- Red Entrance Sign on Route 41: We are still waiting to be scheduled to have the sign repositioned. Their equipment is in high demand.
- Pavers at the Dock at Kids Cove: We are waiting for some pricing information but hope to move forward with this repair very soon.
- New nets have been ordered for the tennis courts.
