NAPLES RESERVE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC. RESOLUTION TO SAFELY RESTART BOAT CAPTAIN TUTORIALS

WHEREAS, the Naples Reserve Homeowners Association, Inc. ("Association") administers the common areas and enforces the governing documents in the Naples Reserve community in Collier County, Florida;

WHEREAS, the Association owns and operates recreation facilities ("Amenities"), which Amenities are part of the Association's common areas; and

WHEREAS, the Association has professional community management personnel on-site in the community's administrative office (Administrative Office") to support the Association's business operation, owners, residents, vendors and guests; and;

WHEREAS, the State of Florida continues to be impacted by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic ("COVID-19 Pandemic"); and

WHEREAS, the Association's Board of Directors ("Board") has endeavored in good faith to balance various competing interests during the COVID-19 Pandemic including serving the Association's members, associate members, residents and guests while also attempting to reasonably protect persons from the potential spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board considers the health and safety of the Association Staff a high priority, and with the current continued spread COVID-19 the Association must remain vigilant in mitigating the outbreak;

WHEREAS, the Board intends to resume operations of the Amenities and the Administrative Office only when permitted by law <u>and</u> when it is determined to be safe to do so in the judgment of the Board;

WHEREAS, the Board hereby adopts the following regarding restarting Boat Captain Tutorials;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference.
- The Board may restart the Boat Captain Tutorials at its discretion, and may, at any time, halt such tutorials as it deems necessary.
- The Board shall establish an appointment schedule and determine safe occupancy for Boat Captain Tutorials with sufficient time to allow implementation of the safety protocols contained herein.
- 4. Masks shall be worn by participants at all times and staff shall provide hand sanitizer.

- 5. The participants will maintain six (6) feet apart at all times, when possible.
- Sanitation of all high-touch areas and boat shall be performed after each appointment.
- 7. Participant's shall limit contact of high touch areas.
- 8. The Association Staff shall endeavor to follow all CDC and OSHA guidelines, which are subject to change based on further information provided by the CDC, OSHA, and other officials. Current CDC guidelines are updated regularly https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html. The Association may also amend this policy based on operational needs.
