

Naples Reserve Approved Plant List

Plants listed below are grouped according to the desired overall design objectives established for Naples Reserve. Plants listed in the Vegetation Not Permitted are not allowed within Naples Reserve. Plants followed by an asterisk * are native to Florida and are encouraged to be used predominately in your proposed landscape.

Any Florida friendly or native plants can be used, as long as it's not invasive. See below, or go to <https://www.ifas.ufl.edu>

Designs will be reviewed and approved by the Design Review Committee (DRC) based upon the use of Florida Neighborhoods & Yards and xeriscape principles.

Homeowners may plant annuals in containers, planters or flower beds on their private property as long as the plantings do not interfere with our Landscape Contractors services (mowing, trimming, weeding, fertilizing, insect control). The homeowner is responsible for maintaining any annuals planted on/at their property including but not limited to irrigation, fertilizing, weed control and insect control of the annuals.

Homeowners are not required to go to the DRC for approval to plant annuals. Homeowners may not plant anything in the common areas of Naples Reserve.
