OUTRIGGER EQUIPMENT RULES

- USE OF ALL WATERCRAFT AND EQUIPMENT IS AT THE DISCRETION OF MANAGEMENT
- NO SWIMMING IN LAKES
- ALL FISHING IS CATCH AND RELEASE UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED
- FISHING IS NOT ALLOWED ON NAPLES RESERVE HOA BOATS
- WATERCRAFT MUST REMAIN 30 FEET AWAY FROM THE SHORELINE
- MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT IS 7 MPH
- MAXIMUM CAPACITIES MUST BE ADHERED TO AT ALL TIMES
- NO ANIMALS ALLOWED ON THE BOATS OR EQUIPMENT
- NO GLASS ALLOWED ON THE BOATS OR EQUIPMENT
- NO SMOKING ALLOWED ON THE BOATS OR EQUIPMENT
- NO DIVING OR JUMPING FROM BOATS OR EQUIPMENT
- NO WADING IN THE LAKES
- DO NOT DISCARD ANY WASTE, FOOD, OR BEVERAGES INTO THE LAKES
- DO NOT FEED OR ENTICE ALLIGATORS
- FISHING CAN ATTRACT ALLIGATORS SO PLEASE PROCEED CAUTIOUSLY
- CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 13 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT
- HOMEOWNERS, TENANTS, AND GUESTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING OF ALL EQUIPMENT AFTER USE
- HOMEOWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY PROPERTY OR BODILY INJURY DAMAGE CAUSED BY THEMSELVES, TENANTS, OR GUESTS
- NO DOCKING OF PERSONAL WATERCRAFT AT THE OUTRIGGER DOCK
- DOCK ACTIVITIES WILL CLOSE 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO SUNSET
- IN CASE OF STORM/LIGHTENING, RETURN TO DOCK IF STORM IS LESS THAN 10 MILES AWAY. ACTIVITY WILL BE LIMITED TO THE MAIN LAKE IF STORM IS LESS THAN 20 MILES AWAY.
- BOATER SAFETY TUTORIAL MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO INDEPENDENT USE OF BOATS
- UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, UNITED STATES COAST GUARD (USCG)
 NAVIGATION AND SAFETY RULES APPLY FOR USE OF ALL WATERCRAFT
- ALL OTHER NAPPLES RESERVE RULES APPLY
- IN CASE OF EMERGENCY DIAL 911
