PROPER EMERGENCY KIT ESSENTIALS FOR HURRICANE PREPAREDNESS

Having the proper supplies on hand is key to being prepared during this year's hurricane season. Keep your supplies in an easy-to-carry emergency-preparedness kit that you can use at home or take with you in case you must evacuate.

Your basic supplies should include:

- * Water: one gallon per person per day for 3 to 7 days**
- * Food: non-perishable, easy-to-prepare items for 3 to 7 days**
- * Flashlight**
- * Battery-powered or hand-crank radio**
- * Pet care: food, cage, leash, immunization record**
- * First aid kit**
- * Medications (7-day supply) and medical information**
- * Multi-purpose tools**
- * Toiletries and personal hygiene items.**
- * Important documents in waterproof container: Medication list, medical records, deed/lease to home, passports, birth certificates, insurance policies, etc.**
- * Cell phone with charger and automobile charger**
- * Family and emergency contact information and car/house keys**
- * Extra cash (ATMs might be inoperable)**
- * Extra fuel for generator and car**
- * Extra batteries for flashlight, clocks, radios, battery operated candles**
