



FAQ: Tobacco-Free Policy

General Rules

Q: Is Naples Reserve a tobacco-free community?

A: Yes, Naples Reserve is a tobacco-free community. Tobacco use, including smoking, vaping, and chewing tobacco, is prohibited in all of the Association's Common Areas.

Q: Where is tobacco use allowed in Naples Reserve?

A: Tobacco use is allowed only within individual homes and lots.

Prohibited Activities

Q: What forms of tobacco use are not allowed in the Common Areas?

A: Smoking, vaping, and chewing tobacco are all prohibited in the Common Areas.

Q: Are there any designated smoking areas within the community?

A: No, there are no designated smoking areas in the Common Areas. Tobacco use is restricted to private homes and lots only.

Compliance

Q: What happens if someone violates the tobacco-free policy?

A: Violations should be reported to Property Management. The Association may take appropriate actions as outlined in the community rules and regulations.

Q: Can I smoke or vape on my front porch or backyard?

A: Yes, as long as your porch or backyard is within your lot, you may use tobacco there.

Visitors and Guests

Q: Does this policy apply to guests and visitors?

A: Yes, the tobacco-free policy applies to everyone, including residents, guests, and visitors, while they are in the Common Areas.
