City of Kirkland has set aside funding for a Tool Library; a shared resource where community members can borrow tools and equipment similar to a traditional library. Learn more and get involved!



NEIGHBORHOOD SAFETY

- At its May 19 meeting, Kirkland City Council approved funding for a project in Everest (+ other neighborhoods) to enhance safety for walkers, bikers and drivers alike.
- The pedestrian overpass at the top of Kirkland Ave makes it an important route for commuters, but the steepness of this street means that traffic flowing down hill often exceeds the 20 mph speed limit
- Approved project will result in a stamped concrete traffic island on Kirkland Ave near Cedar St as a visual speed limit reminder.

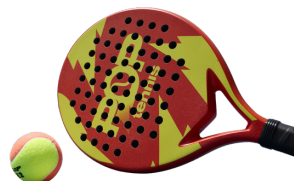


YOU HEARD IT HERE!
