City Updates:

- Kirkland 2044 Comprehensive Plan Update Housing Element: The City of Kirkland is currently updating \its Comprehensive Plan, including the Housing Element. This plan will shape the future of housing in Kirkland, addressing critical issues such as affordability, availability, and equity. The city has released draft goals and policies for the Housing Element, which are available for review on the city website. A public hearing on the Housing Element and other topics related to the Kirkland 2044 Comprehensive Plan is scheduled for Thursday, September 26th, 2024. The open house begins at 4:00 PM, and the meeting will start at 6:00 PM.
- The Kirkland Initiative: This program aims to make City Hall accessible and encourage civic engagement by providing residents with a deeper understanding of local government. The Initiative is an 8-week course that will meet on Thursday evenings from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM, starting September 26th. This course will cover a range of city government topics, from City Council to Public Works to Community Responders and more. The application for the 2024 Kirkland Initiative is now open!
