My Dad always said...if you are From Me to You going to do a job, do it right the first time. So is the story of the St. Clement Hall. When we discovered we could no longer safely patch the tile floor, we had to replace it. Could we have a new floor with paint peeling off the walls? Nope, so the company who painted it 15 years ago did the job, a great one too! And yet why was the paint peeling on the southern wall? As the window coverings were taken down to paint close to the glass edge, we discovered the single pane windows and frames were cracked from extended service beneath the foam board that covered them. They were the culprits that caused moisture leakage; paint to bubble and peel. So that led us to new thermal E tinted windows. 1"thick, which will replace the old ones, giving us far better protection against the elements while reducing our heating and cooling costs.

All that said, we will now have an updated venue space in our area that can accommodate events up to 400 people. And most importantly, bring in extra income for our Parish. So here is our cost breakdown:

Abatement Of Asbestos Floor: \$14,000 Tile: \$10,685 ~ Painting: \$4,775 Windows: \$8,000 (est)

Thank you, Jim Foltz who will be installing the windows himself as a gift to the Church.

A big thank you to all who have contributed to the Building Fund for this project. We have been blessed to receive **\$8,435!**

And a big shout out of thanks to my Father who taught me so many great lessons in the few years I had him on this earth. Happy 100th birthday today, August 29, in heaven, Dad!!!
