WATER IS LIFE!
Safe Water in Tanzania
2 Plumbers or Masons, 2 Days, \$200

Profound results of over 900 wells since 2022! Our vision is a country (Tanzania) where the fears of drinking water from a contaminated open well or falling in and drowning are extinct.

Half of the rural households in Tanzania don't have safe access to clean water and many women must travel an hour or more to collect water in a heavy bucket on their head. Family Well Project partners with rural families, who are required to provide some materials. In just 2 days, team members hand drill a new well or retrofit an existing open well.

On average, over 50 wells are being completed each month. The goal for 2026 is to train an additional 9 teams, doubling the number of wells being done. Each well is used by 5 to 10 families in Tanzania.

There are no overhead expenses in the US since they are all volunteer administrators. Family Well Project is a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Organization. Donations tax deductible if you itemize.
