Did you know?

Saint Valentine of Rome - A 3rd-century Christian martyr, who defied Roman authority. One popular tradition says he secretly married christian couples after Emperor Claudius II banned marriages for young men. (Believing unmarried men fought better). Helping people merry equals breaking imperial law.

There are at least 3 different Saint Valentines recognizes by early church records. Though historians aren't totally sure which one inspired the holiday. Whoever he was, Valentine did really exist, because archaeologists have unearthed a Roman catacomb and an ancient church dedicated at St. Valentine. In 496 Pope Gelasius marked February 14th as a celebration in honor of his martyrdom.

In later years, due to a lack of historical detail, in 1969 the Roman Catholic Church removed St. Valentine from the general liturgical calendar, though he is still celebrated locally.

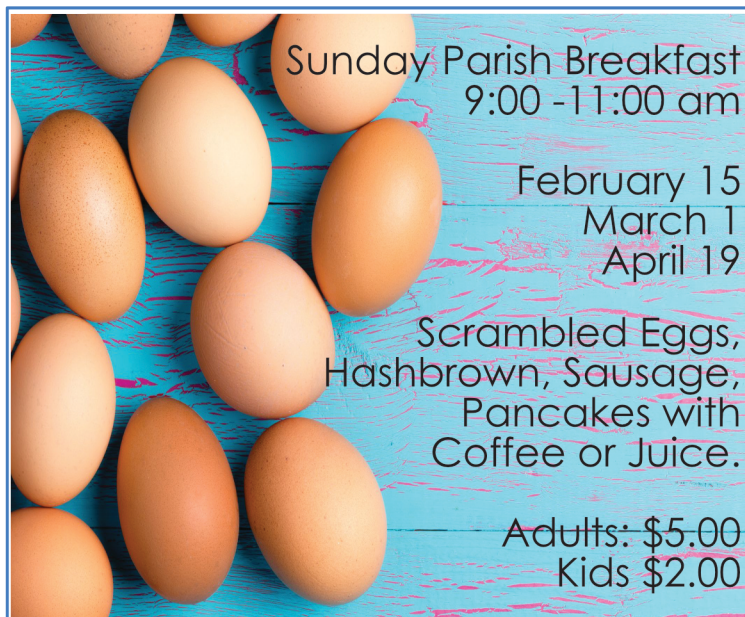
