



Disciple Maker Index Survey

Holy Family Parish

In January and February of 2024, Holy Family Parish participated in the Disciple Maker Index (DMI) survey through the Catholic Leadership Institute. Parishioners were asked to reflect on their own spiritual growth and provide feedback on the efforts of the parish. The survey provided insight on faith formation & spiritual growth, parish ministries & opportunities, and the Sunday experience. The Office of the Pastor team would like to thank everyone who completed the survey.

Let's take a look at some things we learned from you in the DMI survey:

Strong in Belief & Devotion to Prayer



Parishioners are strong in their belief that Scripture is the Word of God, the Eucharist is the Body & Blood of Christ and that the church plays a critical role in one's relationship with the Lord.

Welcome & Accepted

88% Agree or Strongly Agree

or Strongly Agree that they feel welcome & accepted in the Parish



Those who responded to the survey frequently engage in individual prayer. They also reported that they attend Mass monthly or more frequently and many make time for Catholic devotions.

Responses provided feedback about opportunities to grow in our formation as disciples, enriching personal prayer life, and connecting teachings with our own lives and the lives of others.

Over 80% of parishioners who responded have been members for 10 years or more




Mature in Faith

*Our survey response rate of 29% is within a typical range based on data provided by CLI and is slightly better than other parishes in the diocese.



Approach to Giving: How we support the parish financially

Of those who responded to the survey, 90% shared that they do contribute to the parish financially throughout the year. About 59% responded that they make a plan for annual giving and 40% indicated that they tend to give when asked, such as the passing of the weekly collection basket or an appeal for a specific purpose.
