Dear Parishioners,

I've finished my second week of Canon Law Studies. We are half way through the first set of classes. This month we are studying "General Norms 1" and "The Particular Church." General Norms teaches us the principles of interpretation and application which we will use throughout our studies, and "The Particular Church" is all about the Diocese and other institutions that are like dioceses.

One important idea that we have learned in "The Particular Church" is that the Bishop isn't a "vicar" of the Pope. I am a "vicar" of Fr. Kevin. My purpose at our parish is to assist Fr. Kevin in fulfilling his responsibilities to all of you. In contrast Bishop Bonnar isn't in our diocese in order to assist the pope in serving us; instead, serving and leading and teaching us is Bishop Bonnar's own proper responsibility. We don't need to go to Rome and be with the Pope in order to really participate in the Body of Christ; instead, here in Youngstown, united to Bishop Bonnar, we form the Catholic Church that Christ instituted.

If that is a little too heady for you then here is a good practical reminder. The Code of Canon Law obliges us to fast before receiving communion. The fast is an hour before receiving communion. It is **not** an hour before mass starting. Of course the exact time when we receive communion varies depending on how long the homily, readings, and music lasts. Here's a question for you to chat about with your friends, "How long before mass should you start fasting if Fr. Kevin is the celebrant, and how long for Fr. Fritz?"
