

We have two professors this month for our classes. Dr. Budney is a little old lady who has spent most of her life in D.C. and Dr. Martens is a big and tall man who grew up in Belgium. I don't know how Dr. Budney would react if a mouse scurried over her feet during class, but I do know how Dr. Martens reacts.

Twice this week we saw a mouse dart from one floor electrical outlet to another. The first time Dr. Martens didn't notice the mouse, but when we told him he was unsettled by the idea of a varmint in our classroom. After some questioning and answering about the mouse, (How large was it? Where did it go? You're sure that it wasn't a rat?) he told us how he had pet mice as a child. They started off as two but when they began to multiply his mom got rid of them.

The next day the mouse made another appearance, and this time Dr. Martens saw it. He leapt in the air and let out a high pitched shriek. It was not very impressive and I didn't think very highly of him at that moment; however, God quickly humbled me for any derision I felt towards Dr. Martens.

Later that day a 6 inch songbird dove at me. I stayed cool, calm, and collected until I realized that there were two of them and they had me surrounded. Then I was seized with mortal terror. I was flinching and spinning and ducking and weaving like a fool, but I insist that those two tiny birds were scary!

G.K. Chesterton tells us that, "Angels can fly because they take themselves lightly.

" I pray that like Dr. Martens and myself you wouldn't take yourself too seriously, you would renounce pride, and experience humbling moments with good grace and humor.
