A week ago I drove my white car down to my daughter

Olivia who is buying it as her first car. She drove us around Columbus, giving her the feel for the car and familiarizing her with driving in the city (she's been riding her bike back and forth to work for a year and a half!) Being a larger city, there were more homeless



visible on the streets and corners. Late Saturday morning I took a bus home and started thinking about the people I saw. Then it occurred to me how many storage unit businesses we were passing. We heat our

"stuff" in storage units, yet we have people living in the cold. It is true that there are many who choose to live that life without responsibility. And others who have a life on the streets thrust upon them when situations don't work out the way they should.

I started thinking about how I could put FEET ON THE GOSPEL. Which then led me to think how homeless shelters have a great need for socks. So, I am going to start a drive to collect new adult socks for men to bring to the Refuge of Hope in Canton. I will have hampers at each of the Churches for anyone who wishes to throw a new pair or two of socks into the bin. I can get easily overwhelmed by the amount of need in our world.

Putting feet on the Gospel is one step in the right direction.
