Saint Gertrude

Feast Day: November 16

Patron Saint of: The West Indies

Symbols: Sacred Heart of Jesus

Also Known As: Gertrude the Great

Canonized: 1677

Canonized By: Pope Innocent XI

She grew up in a German monastery, educated by the nuns who cared for her. At 25, she began having visions of Jesus that transformed her life, turning her focus from worldly learning to deep spiritual devotion

She developed a great love for the Sacred Heart of Jesus and saw herself as His bride. In one remarkable vision, Jesus exchanged His Sacred Heart with hers.

Gertrude spent the rest of her life praying, serving others, and writing to inspire her fellow nuns.
