Round tables will be set up for each designated hostess who has volunteered to host a table of 6 or 8. The hostess may invite female friends, family or offer open seating.

The day before, she will decorate her table with seasonal and festive décor.

Every table will be different to reflect the personality of the individual.

Hostesses are to provide table settings for their table: plates, cups and saucers, forks, spoons and napkins, table covering. You may use any type of dinnerware you wish including plastic/paper ware or china.

Decorations are to reflect Advent themes.


