ADVENT IS APPROACHING

Traditionally, Advent Wreaths are constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which four

candles are inserted, representing the four weeks of Advent. Ideally, three candles are purple and one is rose, but white candles can also be used.

THE BEGINNING OF ADVENT

On the Saturday before the First Sunday of Advent, the family gathers around the wreath decorated with greens. One candle should be lit.

We gather around our wreath to begin the celebration of Advent. Let us ask our Father in heaven to fill our hearts with grace. Heavenly Father, we look forward to the celebration of Christmas and to the coming of the Lord in glory. Bless this Advent wreath.
