ARCHDIOCESE FOR THE MILITARY

Today, our parish will take up a **2nd Collection** for the Archdiocese for the Military Servers USA (AMS). Established by Saint John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is the only U.S. diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs medical Centers or working in the federal government beyond U.S. borders including those from our own parish and diocese. AMS priests and deacons serve approximately 1.8 million Catholics who hail from 50 states and U.S. territories.

Recently my youngest daughter Teddi drove over to Pittsburgh via Rte 30 to meet a friend for the weekend. She called me when she got into the city, trying to find the Air BnB where they were staying. She was frazzled with the traffic, one way streets, construction and the wild curvy roads of Rte 30. I stayed on the phone quietly as she worked her way through the city, giving encouragement along the way. It is something my girls and I do for one another. We "talk one another home". When I have a long day, I will call one of them and while we catch up, they keep me awake for my 25 minute drive. And in turn they call me to have my voice as a companion if they are in bad rain or snow or traffic. Someday I hope that they make the connection to reach out to the Great Comforter, Jesus Christ and ask Him to sit beside them. Or like that Country song, "Jesus, Take the Wheel".

Our imagination can help us calm ourselves in moments of great anxiety. I've reached my hand to the seat next to me, imagining I can hold His hand in moments of concern. When things got ugly, I hid my eyes behind His back. When I was brave I looked over His shoulder. Invite Jesus in, intimately. 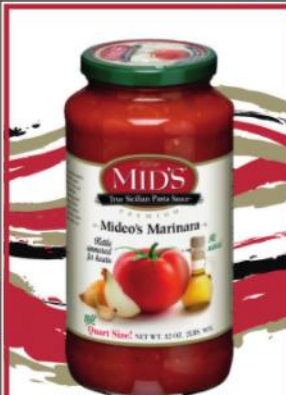
