ARCHDIOCESE FOR THE MILITARY

Today, our parish will take up a **2nd Collection** for the Archdiocese for the Military Servers USA (AMS). Established by Saint John Paul II in 1985, the AMS is the only U.S. diocese responsible for providing pastoral care to men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Dept. of Veterans Affairs medical Centers or working in the federal government beyond U.S. borders including those from our own parish and diocese. AMS priests and deacons serve approximately 1.8 million Catholics who hail from 50 states and U.S. territories.

She was frazzled with the traffic, one way streets, construction and the wild curvy roads of Rte 30. When I have a long day, I will call one of them and while we catch up, they keep me awake for my 25 minute drive.
