St. Elizabeth of the Trinity:

Did You Know? In 1901she entered the Discalced Carmelite convent in Dijon, France at age 21. She had a profound devotion to the Holy Trinity, often writing about God dwelling within the soul, and her spirituality centered on interior peace, surrender, and love of God. Though she died young, her letters and writings continue to inspire many, and she was canonized by Pope Francis in 2016. She is the patron saint of sick people, those struggling with illness, and seekers of spiritual depth.
